### **P185 Ile Molène**

John Head reports (as at 8 Aug 08) that the east cardinal tower (Men Real) and the west cardinal light buoy to the north of the harbour have been replaced with starboard and port hand buoys as below:

Amend WP58 name to read E. Plat. des Jaunes

Add to list and chart WP 99 W. Plat des Jaunes 48° 37'.15N 02° 36'.10W

**P80 St Cast**

Replace description with: ‘ A brand new marina was opened in July 2009 with 750 berths for yachts up to 15m+. Please note that the following information has not yet been checked and should be treated with care.’

Replace Shelter with ‘Believed to be good from all directions following construction of new marina’

Replace Depth Restrictions with ‘ Marina believed to be dredged to 2.0m, but not confirmed’

Replace Berthing with ‘ Pontoon berths in marina up to 15m. Larger yachts may also be accommodated.’

Under Radio, add ‘Harbour telephone 0296810443’

Delete Moorings and replace with

‘A large new marina was opened in July 2009. Details are still scarce, but the marina is believed to be dredged to 2.0m. A plan of the new marina is given below. High season charge for a 10-11m. yacht is given as 28 euros. Yachts larger than 15m should telephone in advance.

Delete ‘Warnings. A new marina is being built....’ And replace with ‘Details given in this section are still subject to confirmation, and should be treated with caution.’

**P 84 Chenal d'Erquy Approaches**

Final sentence, after 255 degrees add '(Line L)'

**P 85 chartlet Approaches to Erquy**

Amend bearing from WP 57 to WP 58 (Line L) to read 255 degrees

Amend name of WP 58 to East Plateau des Jaunes

**P 86 chartlet Le Legue to Dahouet**

Renumber WP 60 (NW of Dahouet) as WP 99 and name 'West Plateau des Jaunes'

**P 87 Dahouet**

Insert WP 99 coordinates below chartlet as '99 West Plateau des Jaunes 48° 37'.15N  
 02° 36'.10W

Approaches, amend text of first sentence to read WP99 in place of WP 58.

Chartlet, WP 59 and Dahouet 147 text should be moved 1 cm to right and up. WP99 should be inserted to left of WB 58,

**P 89 St Briec – Port Le Legue**

Chartlet at top page. Binic WP should read WP61 in place of WP 62. WP 59 and Dahouet 147 text should be moved 1 cm to right and up. WP99 should be inserted to left of WB 58

**p 94 chartlet Rade de St Quay-Portrieux**

Change la Ronde to West Cardinal Mark

**P 141. Primel**

Moorings. Add 'In 2009 these were reported no longer to exist.'

Anchorage. Add at top 'Sandy areas are largely taken up by moorings, and the bottom is largely rocky elsewhere.'

Primel chartlet Delete furthest south green beacon, which no longer exists.

**P 145 Anse de Terenez.**

2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph add after (see approach and details on plan on previous page) 'Line up the point on the west side of bay with the church at Plouezoc'h. Note that this line goes the wrong side of green beacon.'

Add after 'drying moorings for visitors' 'Alternatively anchor or dry out in middle of bay. There is an outstanding neolithic tomb, Cairn de Barnenez, open to public, at SW corner of bay. Provisions from Plouezoc'h, 3-4 kms up hill from south end of bay.'

**P 154 Porz Kernock.**

Delete 'Bow and stern anchors may be needed'. Add 'Outstanding semi tropical garden at east end of island, open to public'

**p165 At La Palue**

Add after 'fuel on the quay' 'from automatic pump which requires a debit card'

**P167 L'Aberbenoit**

Replace 'restaurant and creperie' (St Pabu) with 'restaurant, creperie, and pharmacy.'

**P197 List of Waypoints**

Add WP99 W. Pl. des Jaunes and coordinates 48° 37'.15N 02° 36'.10W

Amend WP58 name to read E. Pl. des Jaunes
